

New Media100 Lab: Section 1003-Assignment 5

Objective:

Use iMovie to edit your video clips into a 1-minute movie.

Purpose:

As a videographer, this exercise presents an opportunity to practice using iMovie to edit your video footage.

Process:

Using iMovie, create a 1-minute movie.

1. Import your footage into iMovie. Create a new Event and name it LastnameFirstname_Assignment5.
2. Create a new project and name it LastnameFirstname_Assignment5.
3. Watch your clips in the event library and make selections using the selection tools- (star, unmark and x).
4. Move the clips you selected into the project window and rearrange them as desired. You must use a clip from each of your 12 source files from assignment 4. They do not have to be of equal length, for example you can use 3 seconds of one clip and 25 seconds of another.
5. Split at least 1 clip.
6. Apply a crop to at least 2 of your clips.
7. Adjust the length of each clip using the clip trimmer.
8. Adjust the color temperature, exposure, contrast, saturation etc... of your clips (when necessary or for creative expression- at least 6 clips).

9. Add transitions and adjust their lengths.

10. Add beginning and end titles.

11. Re-adjust your time if necessary, so that your movie is exactly 60 seconds in length. Use the Precision editor and slip edits to adjust your clips while keeping your project the same

12. Export the movie via Quicktime (located in the Share menu).

13. Save your .mov file to an external flash drive or external hard drive and bring it to your next lab class.

Submit:

Submit a 1-minute finished movie following all of the above steps.

**Name your file in the following convention:
LastnameFirstname_Assignment5.mov**

***Your assignment will not be accepted if you do not follow this naming convention.**

Download your file to a **flash drive** and bring it to class. Be prepared to discuss the choices you made and the steps you took to create this movie in class.

FAQ:

Yes, you have to use iMovie.

Yes, you have to use the video footage you shot for Assignment 4.

Yes, it has to be exactly 60 seconds.

You should spend 1-2 hours on this assignment.
